Family Camp was held a little later than normal this year, in March rather than February. People had a great time and spent the weekend getting to know each other better, and in some cases learning the delicate art of cubby building.



Prayer Weekends are a regular part of our community life. Every two months or so we dedicate a 36 hour period to prayer. The church is left open and people can come in at any time to pray. People who participate in these weekends always find blessing in them.

In July Tim and I travelled to pray at the four corners of inland NSW- Bourke, Hay, Wagga Wagga and Tenterfield. I know they are not strictly "corners" of the state, but they are the towns that represent the region. This has been a project that has been on my heart for several years, but this is the first time I have been able to achieve this goal.

This weekend is taking a lot of organisation and to be successful will need heaps of prayer. I see this as a defining moment in drawing the churches of



this town together in sharing the gospel with the region. We will be looking for everyone to participate in some way over the next 5 months.
