So this is our 21st birthday!

It has been a year of ups and downs, joys and sorrows, but trying to be faithful to the call of God on our life as a church.



One of the high points in 2017 was definitely "Come Together" on the weekend of March 24th to 26th.

Partnering with Billy Graham

Evangelistic Association the Combined Churches of Narrabri presented 5 sessions of Gospel proclamation at the Crossing Theatre. We were joined in this by Steve Grace and his band, Sean

W. Smith, Krosswedz, evangelist Bill Newman and dozens of volunteers from all over Australia. There were many salvations and re-dedications.

It was really pleasing to work with christians from other congregations in planning and running the Come Together event. It was great also to see the commitment of New Life members in terms of planning, facilitating and financing this Kingdom venture.

There are plans coming together to hold a mini-event next April. It will consist of a Families outreach with Sean W. Smith on April 7th 2018.

As a result of this experience I have volunteered to work with BGEA in teaching the Christian Life and Witness Course for other towns around the nation as the need arises.

Cell Groups continue to be the primary expression of New Life outside of Sunday morning. We were sad to temporarily suspend Simon's group but I am confident that it may restart in 2018, and I believe we will be starting an additional group also. The other groups are going strong with dedicated leaders overseeing these groups each week.



In Term 2 I re-launched the Equipping Track, consisting of 4 modules of 5 weeks each. This year I used my Cell Group as the guinea pigs for this, but from next year we will run Sunday afternoon sessions, one module per term. The Equipping Track is all about equipping people for doing the works of Christ, hopefully taking a person from being a new christian to being able to minister to other people.

The Schools Ministry has taken to providing lunch to teachers and other staff members at each of the 3 Staff Development Days held each year. John & Janey, Margaret & David, Chris Silver and I with a couple of other helpers put on a varied menu for 50 or so people. This is another great way to connect with people.



As I write this report we are working towards our first Messy Church service. Messy Church is essentially a missional approach to church in which churches intentionally reach out to the community. I am very excited about perfecting the model and then taking it out to the community to connect with people who have no experience of Sunday morning church.

I find it interesting that after 21 years of New Life the Lord is still leading us into new ways of being church and taking the gospel to our town. I am at an age where many people think about slowing down or retiring, but Margaret and I are still having too much fun to even consider that!

Let's plug into Year 22 with all the grace and anointing we can find in Jesus.
